Darius Brubeck, Anada Shankar, Shalil Shankar and Take That, performing to over half a million people with them on their Wonderland tour. Eleanor has performed in Shanghai, New Orleans, Sydney, Hong Kong and all around Europe and is one of the preeminent harpists of her generation.
